Academic contends on the paper published in Vol. 4, No. 4, S199-203, 2014

A research paper entitled "In-vitro anthelmintic efficacy of Borassus flabellifer against Pheretima posthuma" has been published in Asian Pacific Journal of Tropical Disease, 2014, 4(4), S199-S203. I have some comments on the paper which may kindly be published in your journal.

- 1) Title of the paper is misleading because Pheretima posthuma (presently considered as Metaphire posthuma) is not a helminth, in fact it is an Oligochaete (earthworm) under separate Phylum Annelida.
- 2) The term antihelmintic activity of plant extract is applicable only when the object is a helminthes like Ascaris lumbricoides which does not possess coelom, unlike any annelid like Metaphire posthuma (Pheretima posthuma) which is a colomate.
- 3) Earthworm (not earth worm as written in the paper) in no way resembles round worm parasite, Ascaris lumbricoides anatomically and physiologically (Page 200, 2.4 part, worm collection and

authentication) The clitellum of earthworm is absent in helminthes. The difference between an earthworm like *Metaphire* and an worm, Ascaris is well written in any standard text book on invertebrates.

- 4) I have doubt whether the target species, *Metaphire* (*Pheretima*) posthuma identified were in fact, Pheretima posthuma! This is because clitellate adult of Metaphire (Pheretima) posthuma ranges from 100 to 150 cm in length (never 4-5 cm as written in the paper).
- 5) As Metaphire (Pheretima) posthuma, posseses externally a very thin cuticle (not very thick cuticle as in helmith, Ascaris to protect it from HCL secreted from human gut, any erritating factor present in plant extract can paralise/immobilise leading to death of the worm. So it is not surprising that Borassus extract would have paralytic effect on earthworms.
