1) Short Messaging Service

4) M-OPAC

Library provides users with the necessary information about catalogue by using M-OPAC. Users can search through mobile, how many titles of particular book in library, out of which how many copies are available in the library. With the help of this service library users can access their library records and request their books and update on their mobile device.
