

As Dekić (2009) states, "How I choose the magazine in which I publish – personal view": "Scientific publication is the most important way which communicates science, and the scientific journal is the most important place where new ones are published, original results of some research. Based on this, the science of one country, region, institution is evaluated". From 31 March 2016 to 30 September 2020 – 27 articles by 36 authors were published in the journal. "Academic Publishing House Researcher" is a scientific publishing house in the Slovak Republic. The goal of the editorial policy of the publishing house is the accumulation of the best scientific research on the subject of the publishing journals, reflecting the results of research, scientific and innovative activities of scientists all over the world. The publisher is a member of CrossRef. All scientific publications are assigned DOI. At present time, the publishing house issues the 52 scientific journals of open access. In this group, the journal "Population Processes" occupies a special place. The Journal publishes conference proceedings, articles and brief reports, concerning results of research in the demography in English and Russian languages (Academic Publishing House Researcher, 2021). The director of the publishing house is the leading and respected scientific researcher – the head of the Laboratory of World Civilizations; Doctor of History, Professor Aleksandar Cherkasov.

2. Discussion

Journal "Population Processes", publishes scientific articles that is original scientific papers (papers outlining the previously unpublished results of our own demographic research scientific method; review articles (articles containing original, detailed and critical review of the research of demographic problems or areas in which the author made a contribution, visible on the basis of citations); short or preliminary communication (original scientific paper of full format, or smallscale or preliminary character); scientific criticism, or controversy (discussion on a particular scientific topic based exclusively on scientific argumentation) and review. Also journal, "Population Processes", publishes expert articles, it is a professional work (attachment in which the nude experience useful for improvement of demography science, but which are not necessarily based on scientific method); informative annexes (editorial, comment...); including accounts of scientific and professionals publications, scientific events ... Technically seen journal "Population Processes" encompass abstracts and keywords, then introduction (why it was done and what has been done). materials and methods (what was used and how), results (what happened and what is obtained), discussion (what it all means), references (which was quoted in the text), gratitude (which has helped), the conclusion (which are the causes and consequences), as outlined in the practice of issuing these kinds of serial publications (Rajović, Bulatović, 2016).




Fig. 1. Appearance of the journal "Population Processes 2016–2021 years) (Academic Publishing House Researcher, 2021)

The idea to launch scientific journal came from the director of "Academic Publishing House Researcher" – Doctor of History, Professor Aleksandr Cherkasov in 2016, because of the expressed need to increase the number of publications that would publish papers from various fields of demography. The intention was for the new journal to be open to the widest range of population research areas, but for the authors of the articles to point out the practical implications and the possibility of applying the obtained results in presenting their research. According to this concept,

the name "Population Processes" was chosen. After the decision to launch the journal, further elaboration of the idea and realization of activities necessary for launching the new publication was entrusted to a team of scientific researchers and associates from various scientific disciplines from the "Academic Publishing House Researcher" headed by Professor Aleksandr Cherkasov (Rajović, Bulatović, 2016).




Fig. 3. Representation of the author's country and number of published papers
