Third Dentition-A Clinical Implant Case Report

Introduction

reat discoveries change the course of history. Norms and standards that have taken years and even decades to develop are questioned when new and promising innovations appear. What seemed absolute, the doctrine and principles that guided our decisions and gave us security, becomes just another set of well-developed ideas. Accepted practices are reexamined, and many lose the stature that they held for generations. Such a dramatic, all-encompassing change has occurred in prosthodontics. Oral rehabilitation using titanium implants has become a very predictable treatment alternative during last few decades. The complications are constantly decreasing and the success rate is increasing, with the advent of the osseointegrated dental implant.

A Case Report

Patient came with the complain of difficulty in chewing food, on examination it was found that, only upper central incisors were in healthy condition and all rest posterior teeths were mutilated and fractured, but in lower quadrant teeth were present except lower molars.

All the mutilated and fractured teeth



were extracted, suture was given. After healing before starting of treatment all the diagnosis pertaining to success of implant was done. As patient was having good oral hygene and was having no habits of paan masala and cigarette, implant supported Dr. Vikash Vaibhav

fixed prosthesis was planned for patient. Implants of required dimention was selected, and treatment was planned a surgical guide stent for placement of

implant was made , so that proper angulation for placement was decided. Full thickness flap was removed and after crestotomy implant field was prepared. Followed by this using the stent implant angulations was decided. Implants were placed.

In lower quadrant for replacing lower molar and in upper quadrant 1 implant in canine region, 1 in premolar and one in molar region was placed on both side of arch.

After 4months the second stage procedure was done and gingival former was placed followed by this prosthetic component was attached. With light body putty impression was made and metal ceramic crown was luted . After more 2months i.e after 6months in maxxila second stage procedure was done and prosthesis was loaded .

Metal tryin was done and occlusal











pattern was decided prosthesis was delivered.

was taken and patient was given instruction about hygene maintenance of prosthesis and oral structure.
