D.CloneSpy:

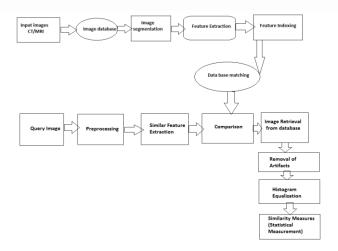
