Figure 6. Section of the outer lip of the shell of *Megalobulimus paranaguensis* number 98, showing the bundles and layers.

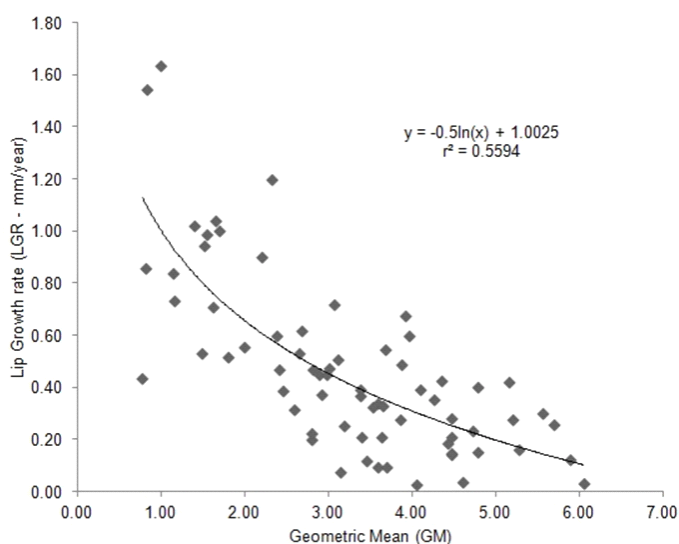
