Cow urine, Cow dung, Cow milk, Curd obtained from cow's milk, ghee obtained from cow's milk are collectively Panchgavya¹. known Acharya Bhavamishra has indicated Cow urine the best in mutra varga. So, when only the term mutra is used, Cow urine is taken as according to anukta pramana². Cow urine is capable of treating many curable as well as incurable diseases. Lot of research has been conducted on cow's urine and immunomodulatory³. hypoglycemic⁴, bioenhancer⁵. antimicrobial⁶ anticancerous⁷ properties have been proved scientifically. Recently, in a study at Junagarh Agricultural University, scientists found Gold in cow's urine⁸ at Dist Gir. Cow urine has been used extensively in Ayurvedic preparations since time immemorial owing its special properties (Table 1)⁹.

Cow urine in Charak samhita-

Acharya Charak has included Cow urine in Ashtamutra. The properties of Cow urine are also described here that it is beneficial in

*Krimi, Kushtha, Kandu and Udar roga*¹⁰. (Table No. 2)

Cow urine in Sushruta samhita-

Acharya Sushruta has described the features of Cow urine as Katu, Tikshna, Ushna, Kshara, Vatala, Laghu, Agnideepaka, Medhya, Pittala and Kaphavatashamaka and it is used in the diseases like Shoola, Gulma, Udarroga, Anaha. It is used for the purpose of Virechana and as Asthapana dravya¹¹. (Table No. 3)

Cow urine in Ashtanga hrdya-

Acharya Vagbhatta has also described Cow urine under *Mutra varga*¹². (Table No. 4)

DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION

Cow's urine is used in the treatment of skin disorders (Kushtha & Kshudrakushtha), GIT disorders (Different of Udar types roga, Anaha, Adhmana, Udavarta, Gulma, Grahani, Arsha, Udarkrimi), Liver disorders (Pandu, Kamla. Shotha), **Psychiatric** disorders (Unmada, Apsmara), Musculoskeletal/Neuromuscular disorders (Vatrakta, Urustambha), Grahabadha, ENT disorders (Naktandhya, Timir, Karnashoola, Karnabadhirya, Karnakrimi. Pakva Pratishyaya, Mukhroga, Galganda) and in

Gynaecological disorders. Cow urine is used in several forms such as Snana, Abhyanga, Parishechan, Svedana, Lepa, Udvartan, Utsadan etc. are done with help of it as a part of Vahya chikitsa upkrama. Aasthapana and Uttarvasti are also given with Cow urine. For Antahparimarjan chikitsa Cow urine also plays a wide role such as intake of Cow urine itself is indicated in the treatment of Shotha, Pandu, Udarroga, Shvitra, Kushtha and Prameha. Cow urine is used in the pharmaceutical processing of yogas as bhavana dravya, paka dravya etc. It is also used as a anupana of aushadha. Cow urine is supposed to be the best in kaphaj rogas. Acharya Charak has indicated to use Cow urine bhavit aushadh in kaphaj vikritis.

Hence Cow urine is the treasure of medicines which is easily available to all. Its medicinal properties are beyond doubt. Requirement is only to validate this ancient knowledge with contemporary research.
