Anjana Yogas in Visha Chikitsa: A Review

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ABSTRACT

Agada tantra is an ashtanga of Ayurveda that deals with toxicology. The substance which causes sadness to the world just at the sight of it, is called visha. Poison is a substance which when introduced into or applied to the body is capable of injuring health or destroying life. It causes damage to tissues, illness or death to the organism. For the management of poison many procedures have been explained by Charaka as Chaturvimshati upakrama. Anjana and nasya are some of the measures which are mostly used in the emergency management of poisoning when the patient is in unconscious state. This article highlights the three important anjana yogas mentioned in visha vaidya jyotsnika.

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INTRODUCTION

Agada tantra is a branch of Ayurveda that deals with management of various poisons. Toxicology deals with various types of poisons- plant, animal origin poisons, etc. and its management. In treatment of visha, acharya Charaka has explained the chathurvimsati upakramas (24 treatment procedures). Anjana is one among the chaturvimsati upakrama mostly used in the management of poison in state of unconsciousness. A literary review in Visha vaidya Jyotsnika has put light on the following anjanas:

- Mrityunjaya anjanam
- Garudanjanam
- Dasabeejanjanam

Mrityunjaya Anjanam:¹

It consists of four mineral drugs, three herbal drugs and eggs of ant. The mineral drugs are Tuttha (Copper sulphate), Gandhaka (Sulphur), Parada (Mercury), Sasyaka (Copper sulphate). The herbal drugs are Swetha gunja (Abrus precatorium), Purana mulaku (Capsicum annum) and Bakula (Mimusops elengi)

Garudanjanam:⁵

It consist of seven mineral drugs namely Anjana (Stybnite), Saindhava lavana (Rock salt), Tuttha (Copper sulphate), Tankana (Borax), Parada (Mercury), Tamra (Copper), Shankha (Calcium carbonate) and seven herbal drugs Shunti (*Zingiber officinale*), Maricha (*Piper nigrum*), Pippali (*Piper longum*), Nili (*Indigofera tinctoria*), Nagadanti (*Baliospermum montanum*), Shigru (*Moringa oleifera*) and Jambeera (*Citrus lemon*).

Dasabeejanjanam¹⁰

It consist of four mineral drugs namely Tuttha (Copper sulphate), Tankana (Borax), Anjana (Stybnite) and Saindhava lavana (Rock salt). The ten herbal drugs are Neeli (*Indigofera tinctoria*), Tulasi (Ocimum sanctum), Danti (Baliospermum montanum), Shigru (*Moringa oleifera*), Nimba (Azadirachta indica), Shireesha (Albizia lebbeck), Maricha (*Piper nigrum*), Bakula (*Mimusops elengi*), Gunja (Abrus



precatorius) and Karanja (Pongamia pinnata).

DISCUSSION

Anjana is on among the chaturvimsathi upakrama mentioned by Charaka. All the three anjanas are herbomineral preparations. It is applied in both eyes of patient in case of snake bite when patient is in altered state of consciousness. Once the patient regains consciousness other treatments should be carried out. The poison with its penetrating qualities damages the eyes which is dry and irritating. To counter this application of collyrium is suggested. Drugs like pippali, maricha, yavakshara, vacha, saindhava lavana, shigru are macerated with the bile of rohitaka fish and applied as collyrium to destroy the poison in the eyes. Sufficient quantity of ghee should be drunk to prevent dryness and irritation in the eyes¹⁰.

CONCLUSION

Anjana is told as one of the chaturvimshati upakramas by Charaka. It is used in the treatment of visha specially in gaining the consciousness in snake bite cases. In Visha Vaidya Jyotsnika three anjana yogas are mentioned namely Garudanjanam, Mrityunjaya anjanam and Dasabeejanjanam. These anjanas are a combination of Herbal and mineral drugs.

Pippali, maricha, yavakshara, vacha, saindhava, sigru, etc. drugs are commonly used for anjana because of its teekshna property. Most of the drugs are having katu rasa, ushna veerya, laghu teekshna guna and properties like vishaghna, vrunahara, krimighna, hrudya, etc. properties.



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
