On the occasion of "3 December", the World Day for Disabled People, the **Society of Disabled People's Organizations of Macedonia**, commencing this year, established a **reward – A Medallion for Special Merits in Society's work and activities**. The Society's council decided the first award to be awarded to Mr. Dushan Neshevski as recognition for special merits in his long-range professional and voluntary engagement in organization, development and improvement of organizations for disabled people.

Vancho Karanfilov, Branimir Jovanovski and Olivera Nikolovska-Bikova received rewards and credits for their exceptional achievements at Para-Olympic Games in Athens 2004.

For the seventh time, a financial reward, amounting to 10.000 denars, was awarded to **Miss Vasilka Galevska for the best student's achievements with average success (9.83) for the academic generation 2001/2004** by the Institute for Special Education and Rehabilitation. **Prof. Dr. Ljupcho Ajdinski, retired full professor, provides the financial reward from his own funds each year.**

At the end of the formal meeting, the students from special schools "Idnina", "Dr. Zlatan Sremec", "Dimitar Vlahov", "Partenie Zografski" and the student Miss Iskra Dineva realized a program.

More than 150 representatives of organizations of disabled people, Association of Special Teachers, Institute for Special Education and Rehabilitation, representatives from the Parliament of Macedonia, led by the vice president of the Parliament **Mrs. Liljana Popovska**, the mayor of Skopje, **Mr. Risto Penov**, representatives of the Ministry for Labor and Social Policy, education and health care, as well as other organs and organizations took part at the formal meeting.
