were taken as universe.

SAMPLE:

50 students each were randomly selected from 4 Higher secondary schools (two arts

schools of Arts stream and (two schools of commerce stream). In this way total 200 students

(100 boys and 100 girls) were randomly selected from four Higher secondary schools of Anand

town.

RESEARCH METHOD

The researcher used survey method in the present study.

METHOD OF ANALYSIS OF DATA:

The researcher prepared opinion sheet with help of experts and teachers of the subject.

Opinion sheet was given to sample students to know hardners of technical terms hardners of

terms was also asked from subject teachers. Then technical terms were tabulated in hard and easy words according to score obtained by students.

FINDINGS:

- 1. Technical terms which were more hard for teachers were considered rather hard by students.
- 2. Technical terms which were hard were considered 'rather hard' than 'ordinary hard' by students.
- 3. Technical terms which were rather hard were considered most hard by students.
- 4. technical terms which were easy were considered most hard by students.
- 5. technical terms which were most hard were considered ordinary hard by boys and girls.
- 6. Technical terms which were hard were considered 'rather hard' by boys and girls.
- 7. Technical terms which were hard were considered rather hard by all the four school students.
- 8. Technical terms which were hard than ordinary hard were considered hard by Arts students and rather hard by commerce stream.
- 9. Technical terms which were easy were considered rather hard by the students of both the stream.

CONCLUSION:

- 1. There was no significant difference between boys and girls in term of hardness of technical terms.
- 2. Technical terms which were considered hard by Arts students were considered rather hard has commerce students.
- 3. There was no significant difference among four schools in terms hardness of technical terminology.

SUGGESTIONS:

1. Gujarat state text-book Board should prepare list of technical form in each subject with the help of experts.
