Overall review of students was positive in terms of quality of paper and printing, content, selection of prose and poetry and it was according to age group. Some suggestions are given by them.

SAMPLE:

200 students (100 boys + 100 girls) (20 students of each ten school) were randomly selected from selected five schools of urban area and five schools of rural area from secondary schools of Anand district.

METHOD:

The present study was explored by using survey method.

TOOL:

Self-prepared questionnaire.

METHOD OF ANALYSIS OF DATA:

Percentage were calculated to compare the data.

COLLECTION OF DATA:

After preparation of questionnaire the researcher contracted the concerned principal of secondary school and made them convinced regarding the objectives of the study. Then the researcher gave questionnaires to selected schools, to fill the information. After completion of scheduled time the researcher collected the filled in questionnaire from the students. The collected data were fed up to S.P.S.S. software programme and analysed them in tabulated form for comparison.

ANALYSIS OF DATA AND DISCUSSION:

- (1) 97% students told that the Hindi text-book is according to age group.
- (2) Quality of paper and printing were of high quality. (98%)
- (3) Inclusion of various literature forms is admirable (94.5%)
- (4) Selection of content is done considering life of the present era. (96.5%)
- (5) Prose and poetry are selected wisely. (95.75%)
- (6) Handbook (book of terminology) for teachers should be prepared. (80%)
- (7) Suggestions for further reading should be given of the end of loss on (79.2%)

FINDINGS:

(1) Majority of the students told that Hindi text-book o Std. IX is according to agegroup of the students.

- (2) Majority of the students said that quality of paper and printing were of very high standard.
- (3) Most of the students opined that content of the text-book was satisfactory.
- (4) Inclusion of various forms of literature was admirable.

- (6) Some suggestions were given by students like to prepare Handbook of the text book and to give exercise for self-study of the end of the lesson.

CONCULSION:

There was no bias in responding of questionnaires among students of rural and urban area schools or sext of the students (i.e. boy or girl). The overall review of Hindi text-book of Std. IX was positive in terms of content, quality of paper and printing, selection of prose and poetry, inclusion of various literature forms etc.

Some suggestions were made by the respondent students to prepare Handbook for teachers and to give exercise for self-study at the end of the lesson.
